Recap- What is our RRSA Outright campaign focus this year?

This year's campaign is all about **children and young people's right to the best possible health and the systems that support it.**

What is a health system?

Health systems are made up of the people, organisations and resources (medicines, hospitals etc) that look after everyone's health.

We have spoken a lot about health systems around the world.

Making health systems stronger around the world is a big challenge, but it's a problem that we can't ignore. It's also a problem that we must all work on together – both adults and children. Richer countries must also help poorer countries achieve this.

Article 12 says: Children have the right to give their opinions freely on issues that affect them. Adults should listen and take children seriously.

Remember-The voices of children are just as important as the voices of adults in calling for change on important issues.

If we could invite in a person who works for a health system or someone in another role, like a government official working on health systems strengthening or advocating for everyone to have equitable access to healthcare. What could ask them? Can you think of any questions as a group?
